


Tour of the

The Danish Home of Edison, now known as DANE (Danish Archive North East), has previously served as a retirement facility, but now houses not only the DANE archives, but a museum, gift shop, and numerous displays relating to the history of our area's Danish population. Members of the Society and public who would like to tour the archives and museum should meet at the rear main entrance of the building, which is located at 855 New Durham Road in Edison (near the 287 exit ramp). Ample parking is available in the rear, adjacent to the entrance. Light refreshments will be served following the tour.
